 \blacktriangleright Neal Martin – In the bottle 91 pts "The 2019 Beauvillage has an engaging bouquet of vivacious brambly red berry fruit laced with cedar and black pepper. The palate is medium-bodied with sappy black fruit, cedar and touches of graphite. As I mentioned from barrel, this is very harmonious with a persistent finish. Highly recommended."

Area: 25 hectares Terroir: clay-limestone and gravel Encépagement: 55% merlot & 45% cabernet sauvignon Average age of the vines : 35 years Pruning of the vine: double guyot Leaf thinning: mechanical

System of vine cultivation: herbing in the rows since 1995

Environmental Certification: HVE level 3

VINIFICATION & AGEING

Harvest: mechanical with sorting optimization

Sorting of the grape harvest: egger-sorter in the cellar

Fermentation: cold pre-maceration for 3 days

Vinification: traditional, thermoregulated with separate grape varieties over a period of 28 days **Pressing**: vertical press Ageing: 12 months in oak barrels, ceramic toasting, medium intensity Alcolhol content: 14% Vol.

Merlot: 55 % **Cabernet Sauvignon**: 45 %
